Statement of Intent for Energy Company Obligation 4 (ECO4) and Great British Insulation Scheme (GBIS) Flex

This "Statement of Intent" sets out the participation of **Rugby Borough Council** in the Energy Company Obligation (ECO4) and Great British Insulation Scheme (GBIS) Flexible Eligibility (Flex) scheme as of **09/05/2025**, with the intent to identify households that may benefit from the installation of a measure as part of an ECO4 or GBIS project.

ECO4 and GBIS place legal obligations on energy suppliers to deliver insulation and heating measures to homes, with the aim to reduce home heating costs for fuel poor households and the least energy efficient homes. The Flexible Eligibility (Flex) component of ECO4 and GBIS allows Local Authorities (LAs) to identify and refer consumers that live in private tenure properties and are considered low-income, fuel poor, or vulnerable to the effects of living in a cold home.
